Dear Brian,

Regrettably due to a clash with another race meeting that the Group S Racing Association had already committed to, Group S entries to the ARDC Sports Car Carnival at Eastern Creek on 20/21 June were well short of expectations.

Notwithstanding this, and given the prospective loss of race meetings that may follow the closure of Oran Park, the GSRA is keen to support Group S involvement at the 2010 ARDC Sports Car Carnival.

Accordingly the GSRA suggests that the ARDC continue to liaise with the GSRA about a Group S commitment which the GSRA would envisage as a dedicated Group S grid under fifth category rules, featuring Group S cars that are in full compliance of Group S eligibility criteria.

But in proposing this program, it is essential that the ARDC meeting not conflict with HSRCA and FoSC meetings in NSW, and not conflict with all historic meetings in Victoria and Queensland.

The ARDC meeting should be desirably four weeks removed from other GSRA commitments which would allow the ARDC meeting to be included in the 2010 GSRA pointscore competition.

The GSRA looks forward to working with the ARDC in promoting an excellent Group S program that will be supported by GSRA members.
